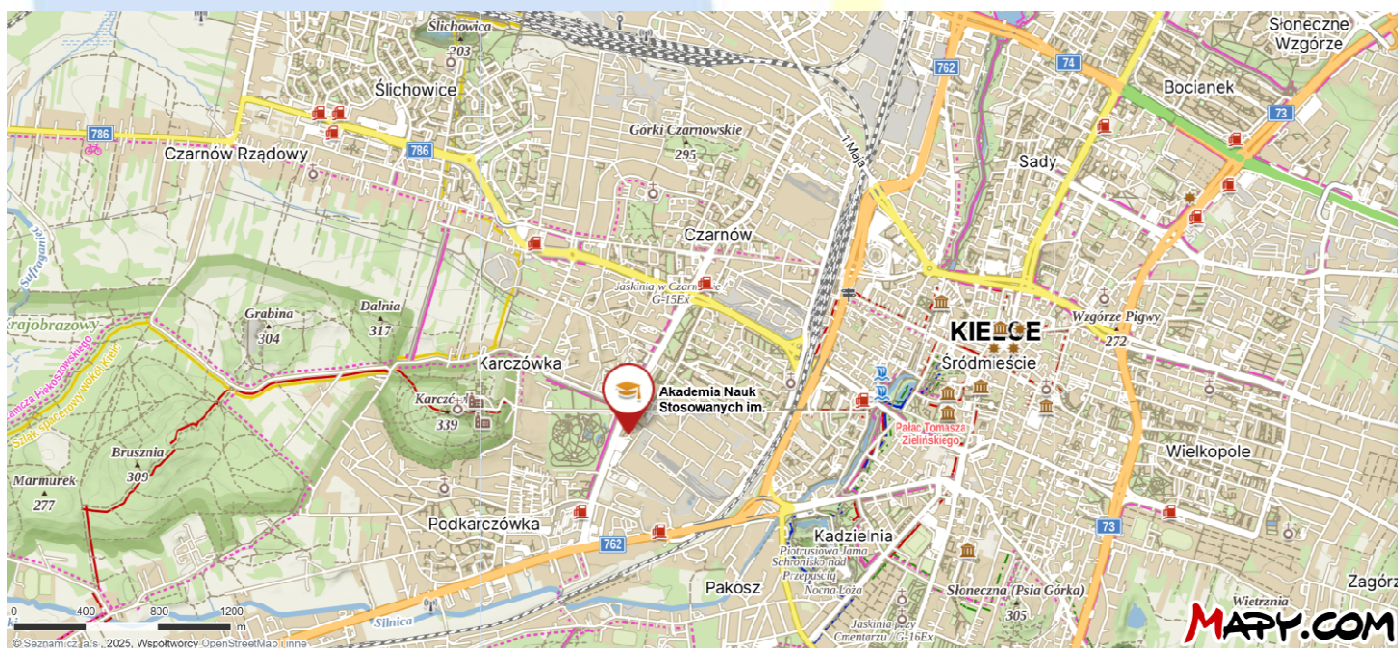

Getting to Kielce:

Nearest airports – Kraków (KRK), Katowice (KTW) and Warszawa (WAW)

From Kraków airport take the train to Kraków Główny and from there a train to Kielce Główny or a bus.

From Katowice airport there is a direct train to Kielce, or you can take a bus to the centre and take a train from there

From Warszawa airport you can take a direct bus to Kielce (Flixbus) or take a train to Warszawa Służewiec and from there a train to Kielce Główny.

Trains and buses run regularly, so it is unlikely that you will have to spend more than an hour waiting for your transportation. You can check the timetables at <https://www.e-podroznik.pl>

Getting to the university:

The university is located ca. 2 km from the city centre and can be easily reached on foot.

By bus:

Bus numbers 1, 5, 23, 28, 31, 35 to Karczówkowska/Jagiellońska

By taxi:

Bolt, Uber and FreeNow operate in Kielce and a single fare from the centre will probably not exceed €3

Important facts

Currency: The currency in Poland is złoty 1 zł = ca. 0,24 €. Every shop and restaurant accepts card payments.

Weather: The beginning of July in Poland is usually warm and sunny with little rain and temperatures of ca. 15-25 °C. However, this year is unusually cold, so be sure to bring a jacket and raincoat or umbrella. Please bring comfortable clothes and shoes, because roughly half of the programme will take place outdoors.

Cuisine: Polish cuisine is rich in meat (mostly pork) with a large selection of soups and generous use of vegetables. Every restaurant (other than fast food or pizzeria) also serves fish and vegetarian dishes. Kielce has a rich restaurant scene which offer varied cuisines from all over the world.

Emergency: In an emergency, dial 112 from your phone. 112 Emergency Response Center ensures the processing of received calls and transferring them to the relevant services: police, fire department, or ambulance.
